Opening Remarks:

Zone and District Report:

- There has been no district meeting
- We have had a zone meeting, and at the meeting 3 Kubota's were bought, one for Orangeville, one Georgina and one for ADSC.
- Giuce mentioned that the zone was upset regarding selling of Trail Permits at Mission Cycle in Angus. Barrie had already put in Trail Permits but it is our Catchment Area. Mission Cycle would like to make Trail Permits available from both clubs and let purchaser decide. The Zone has agreed to leave it at ADSC's discretion for this year and we now have Trail Permits available at Mission Cycle.



Trail Report:

- Trail Guides were given to all Trail Captains
- Jeff little is not letting us go through his property. Grading was done on the 5th side-road and he is quite angry and will not let us through. He told Giuce to leave and for us to re-route the trail. Giuce is looking into a possible lead.

Dave's trail:

- All are marked from the Cty Rd 21 to the 6th Conc. however there are no stop signs up yet. Third line of Essa and 5th Sideroad a few areas lost stakes after farmers gave us the go-ahead to stake and then brought their tractors through. We need a lot of dirt and river rocks on the sixth in Tosorontio. One more weekend and Alliston trails should be done

Ricks Trails:

- Dufferin Forest is two thirds done. Between Dufferin and Simcoe, someone went in with a chainsaw and took down a bunch of trees. The 20th and Airport still needs to be done. Mike knows Dr. Vanderzaag, and is going to see if we can put our trail through his property on the North Side and that way we can get out of the sub-division this year. We need to put a gate or fence in at Rob Somerville's to keep out ATV's, and he would like it up this year. We have the gate to do that and would need two posts to extend the fence he has. Mike, Scott and Keith will go out on the weekend to have a look at it and let us know. Bridge needs to be fixed in Glencarin. Mike and Scott will bring in lumber.

Steve's Trails:

- We're still waiting for some of the crops to come off. We need a big culvert put in on County Road 56.

Groomer and Equipment Report:

- The tracks are on. We should probably get some sealant to use for the tire that leaks. Paul will ask the zone for funds for the sealant. Bonsecour has two tires for sale, they're \$150.00 each
- Chainsaw needs sharpening, and we need two tires and one rim for the ranger. Paul talked to Georgina about having their tires and they will exchange them, but they want our old bald ones, we would need two front ones and a rear.
- We are missing a couple of post-pounders
- The new stakes we have break very easily and the reflectors are falling off.
- Wood screws are needed, new bits and lots of nut drivers.

Trail Patrol:

- We had a course and a few people showed up. We would like to have another one in January. We should try to get patrolling out in the late evenings because that seems to be the time when you find a lot of sleds without permits.
