Obtaining Your 2011-2012

Classic Snowmobile Trail Permit is as EASY... as 1, 2, 3...

1. Fill in the attached application form (remember, you need one form for each Classic Permit you order)

2. Enclose a copy of your Motorized Snow Vehicle Registration Slip (ie. Snowmobiling ownership)

3 Forward the completed application form, **remembering to select your choice of club with in District 4 you wish to support, (Alliston, Bonsecour, Dufferin, Georgina, Hillsburgh, Holland Landing, Orangeville)**, and payment to the OFSC District 4 office

- If you are paying by credit card, you may either mail or fax your application package to the District 4 office.

- If you are paying by cheque, money order or cash, you must mail your application package to the District 4 office. All cheques must be made payable to , SOTBA, OFSC District 4 .

Your 2011-2012 Classic Permit will be forwarded to you via Canada Post.

CLASSIC PERMITS

Great news..... Classic Permits are available again this year for your sleds that are 15 years old or older! Since we know that you will want to ride as soon as the snowmobile trails open for the season, we are sending an application form directly to you. So, fill this out (include a copy of your ownership and payment), get it back into us, and you may just receive your Classic Permit before the flakes start to fly!

Program Particulars

What is the Price of a Classic Trail Permit?

A Classic Trail Permit is \$125 again this year. That means you are able to ride all of the same great OFSC trails for HALF the cost of a regular full season permit.

Who Qualifies for a Classic Permit?

All motorized snow vehicles that are 15 years old or older. So if you own a snowmobile that is a 1997 or older...your machine qualifies!!

What If You Have More than One "Classic" Sled?

That means that you are entitled to purchase more than one Classic Permit! Feel free to photocopy the enclosed application form for as many classic sleds as you own. Just make sure you send in one application per sled.

I Sent a Copy of My Sled Ownership with my Application

Last year...Do I Have to Send it Again?

YES! The Ministry of Transportation requires proof of ownership every year you purchase a Classic Trail Permit.

What if my friend has a "Classic" Sled?

Terrific...now you have a riding partner! You can make them a copy of your application form to fill in, or contact the District 4 office, and we will make sure they receive one. After that, the same ordering procedure applies.
